In addition, this legislation required a minimum of five years as a lieutenant or higher prior to being promoted to chief. This ensures a transition where fire chiefs are learning necessary leadership skills at different levels within the organization. This potential lack of training or understanding of fire situations can seriously jeopardize the lives of the brave men and women on the scene of a fire under the direction of the chief.
