Those who do decide to become volunteer firefighters and undergo training, oftentimes are required to dedicate upwards of 20 hours a week on top of their regular employment to complete this training. In addition to the additional hours, many firefighters who undergo these trainings have to travel long distances because of a lack of training courses close to home. This adds time onto the commitment of completing the qualifications and serving the community. Federal regulations apply to all fire departments in New York State and require that members be provided with training and education commensurate with the duties and functions that such members are expected to perform. OFPC and the Department of Labor's Public Employees Safety and Health Bureau (PESH) and fire service organizations have developed a recommended set of "Best Practices" for use by fire departments to assist fire departments in complying with the Federal regulations. The goal of this study is for OFPC to evaluate these minimum qualifications, or best practices, recommended to become a volunteer firefighter while considering the shortage that is having an effect on communities across the state.
